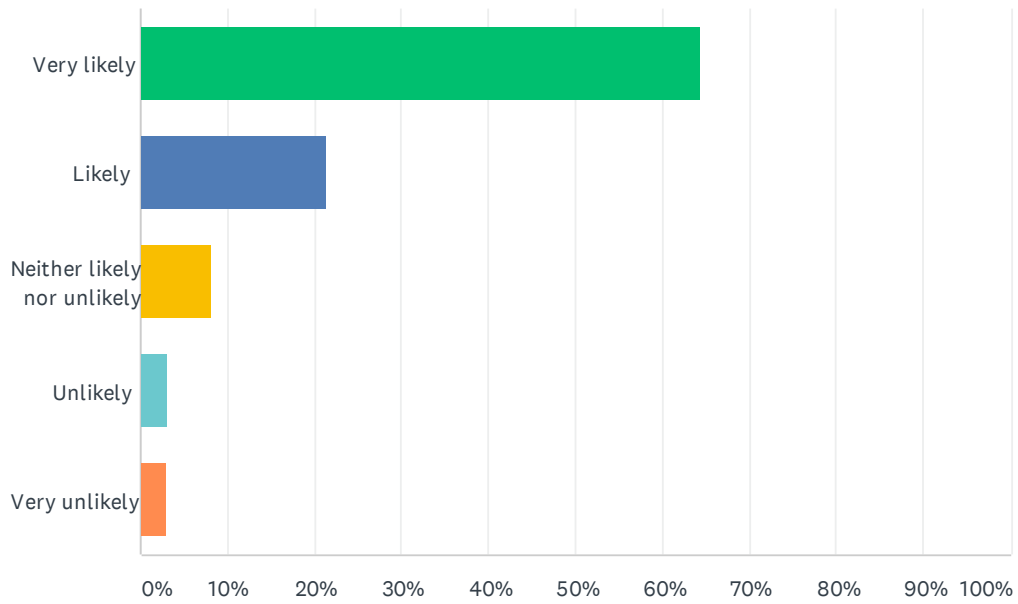


# Q1 When school reopens for in-person instruction, how likely are you to send your child?

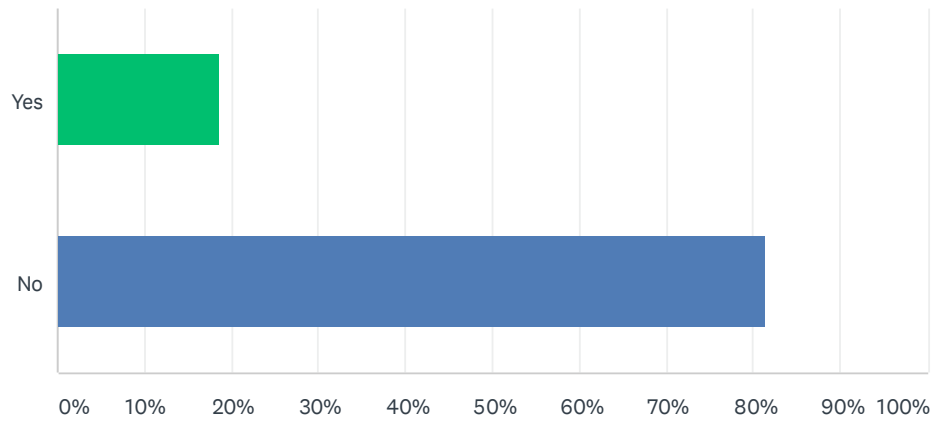

## Q2 When school reopens for in-person instruction, would you prefer that your child wears a mask?

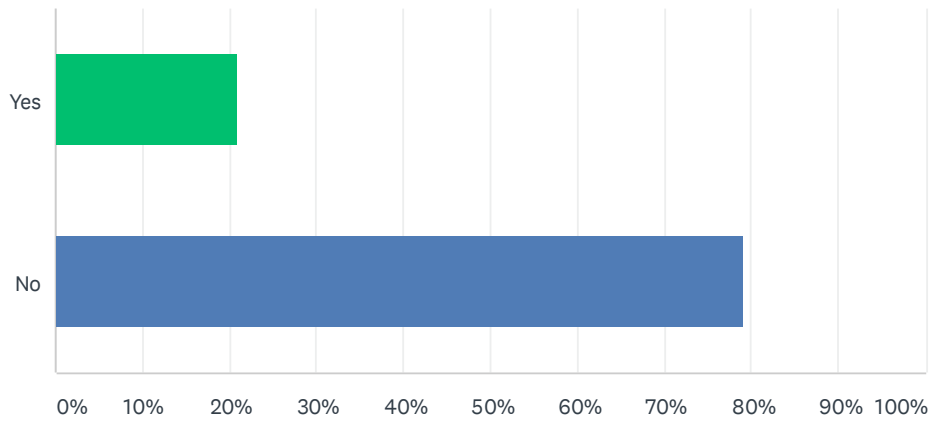

### Q3 When school reopens for in-person instruction, would you prefer that your child's teachers wear a mask?

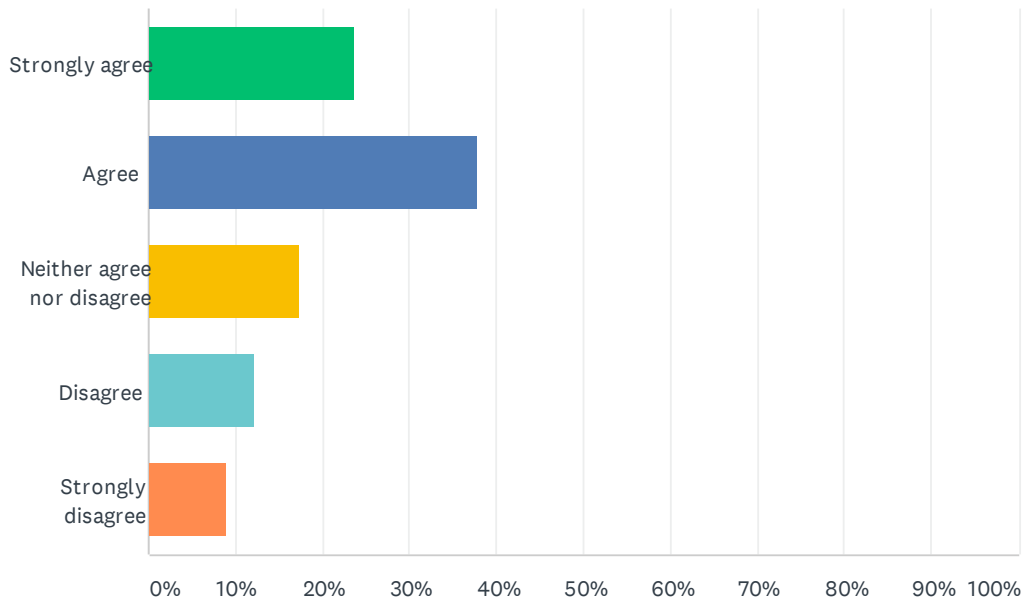

## Q4 My child is prepared for short-term remote learning should it happen again?

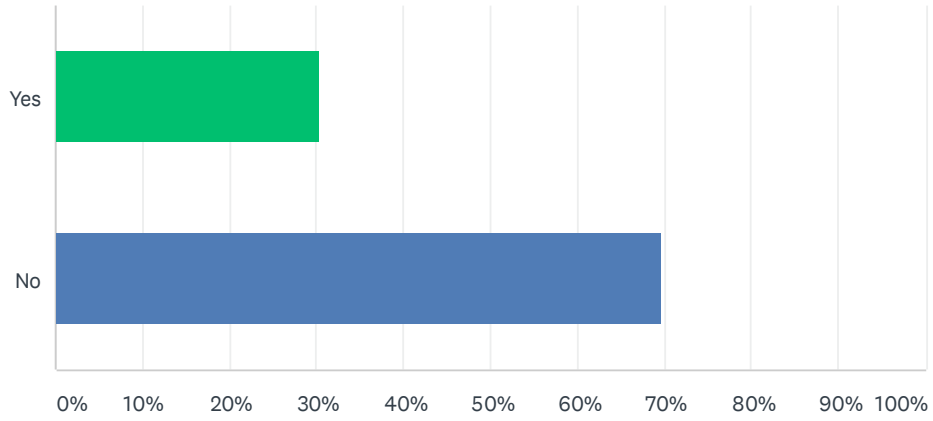

### Q5 Do you have regular daily contact with someone who would be considered “high risk” for contracting COVID-19?

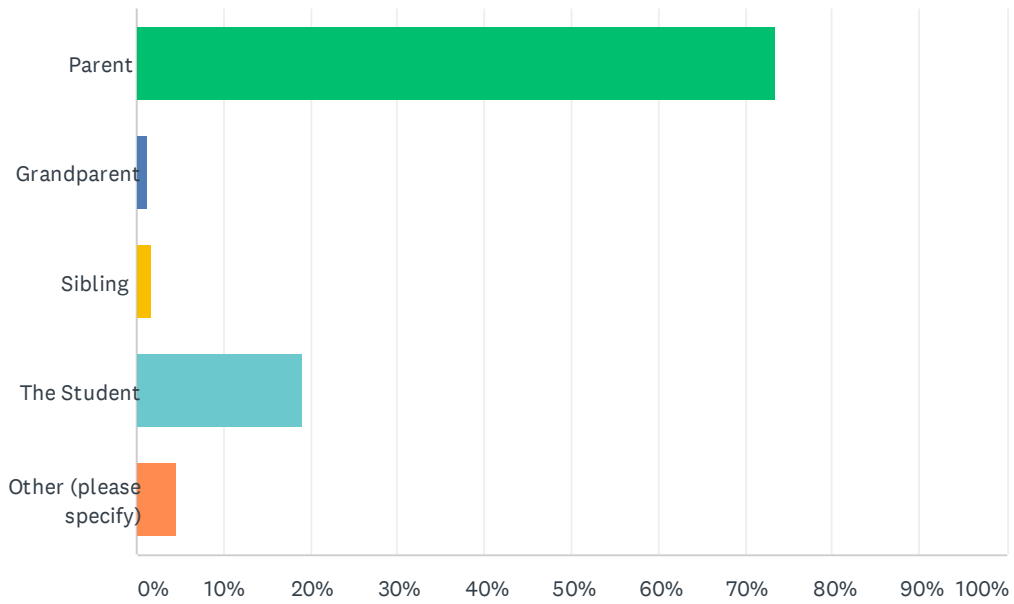

## Q6 When it comes to helping your child with remote learning, who is most responsible for keeping that child on track with their learning?

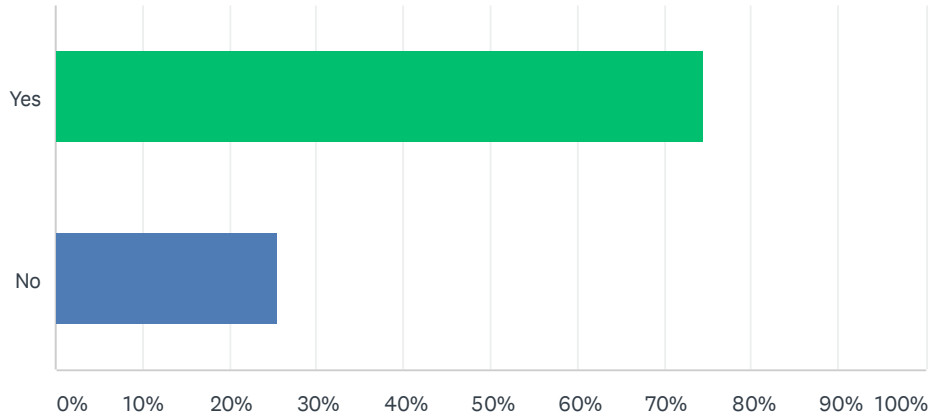

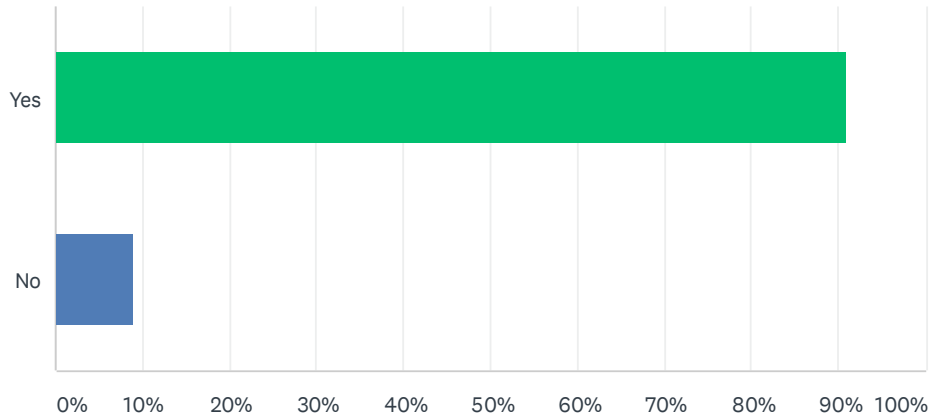

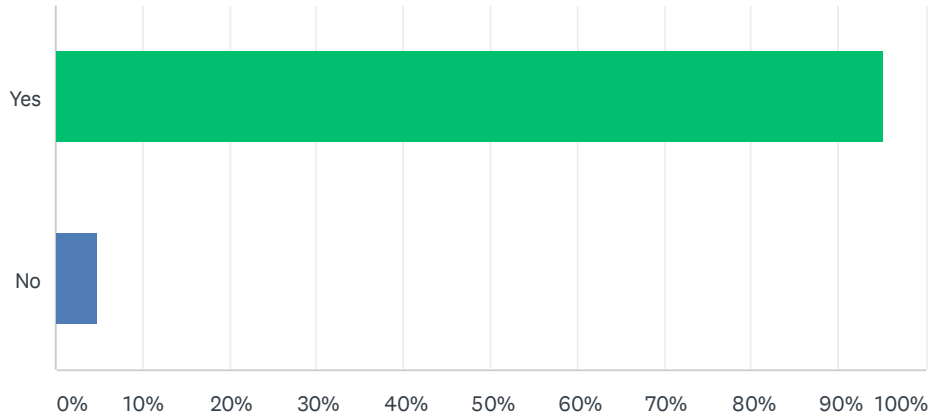

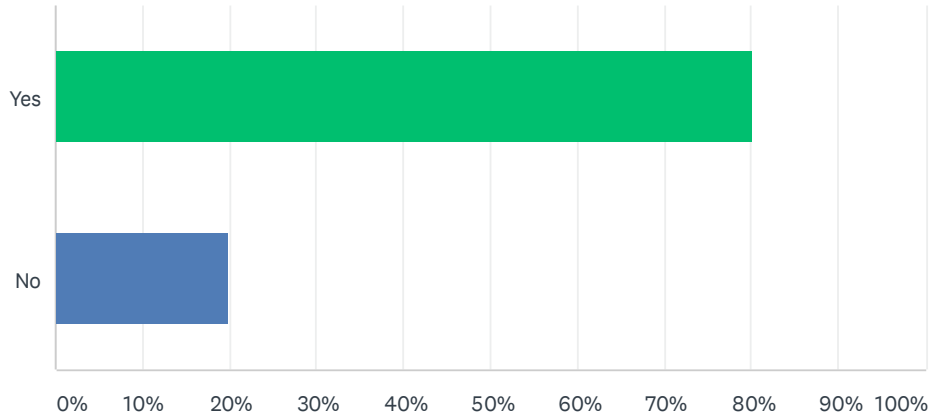

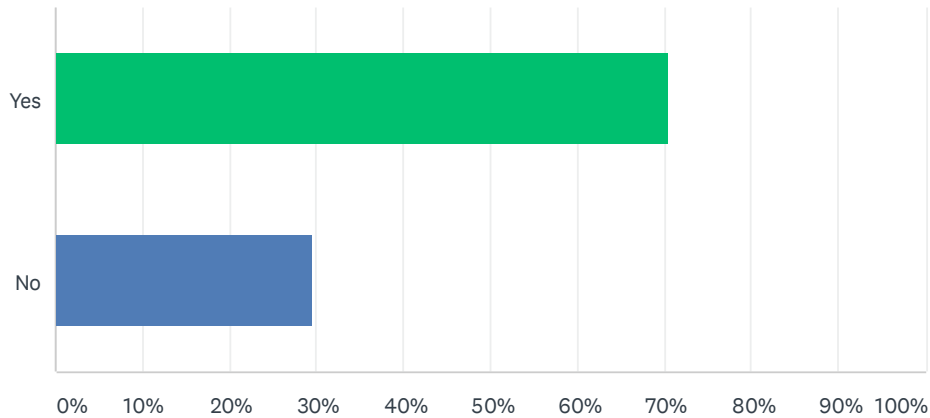

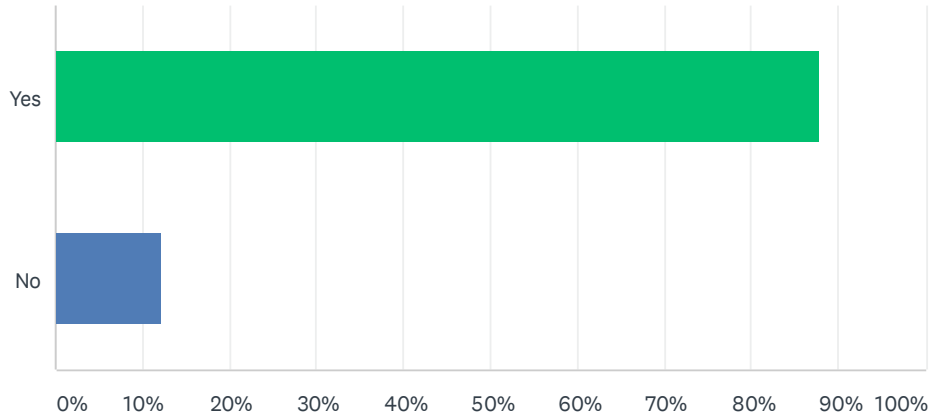

### Q12 If busses are required to be at a lower capacity, are you willing and able to drive your child to and from school?

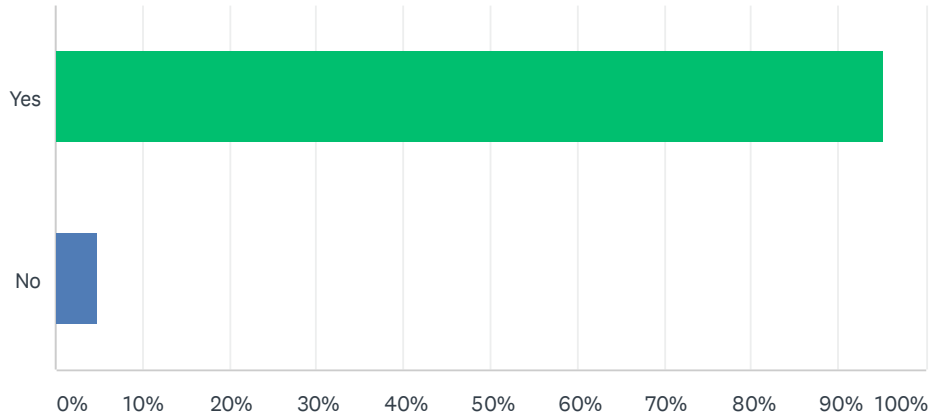

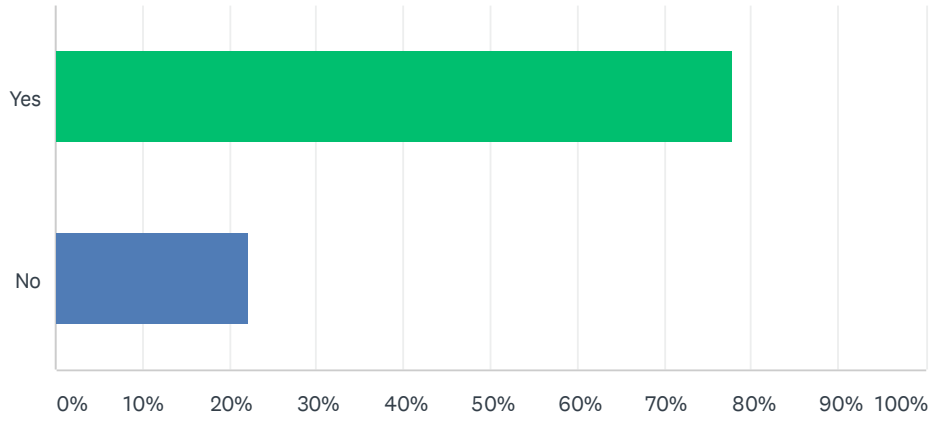

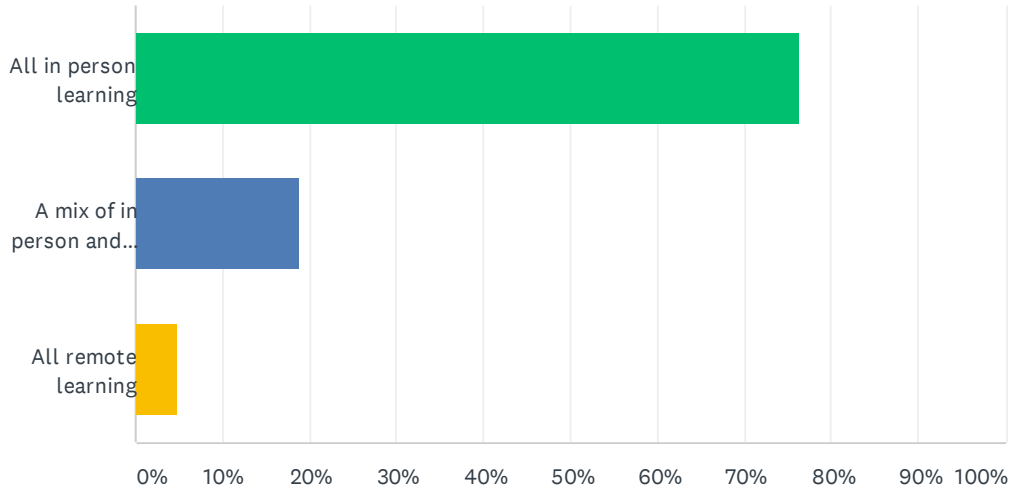

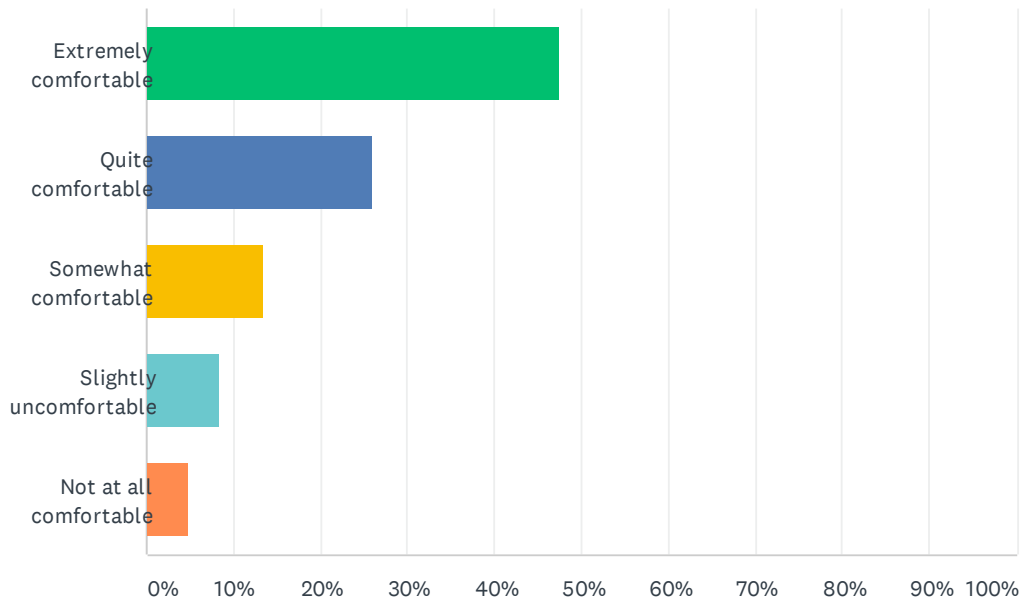

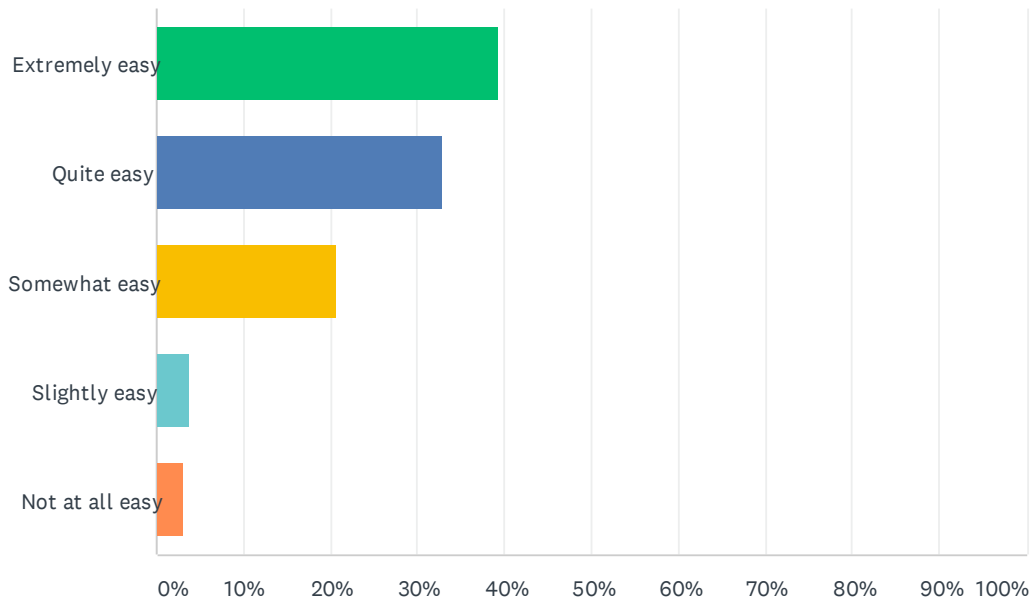

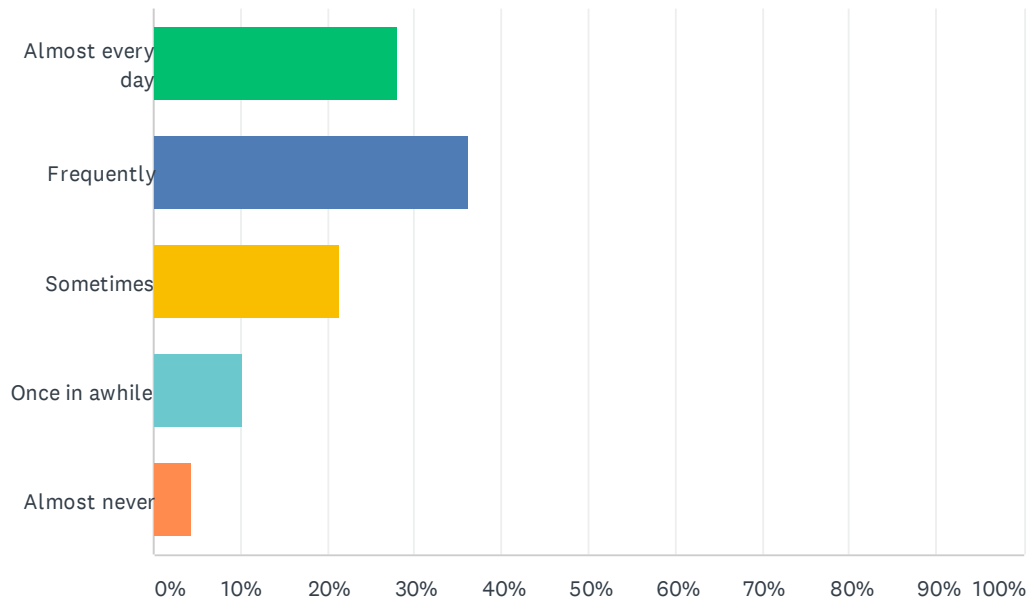

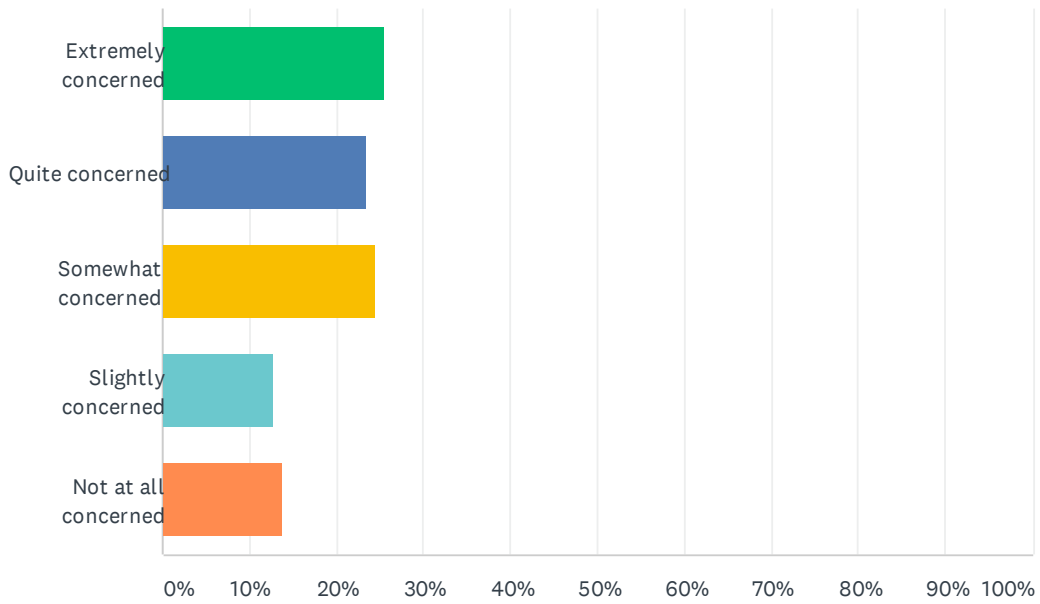

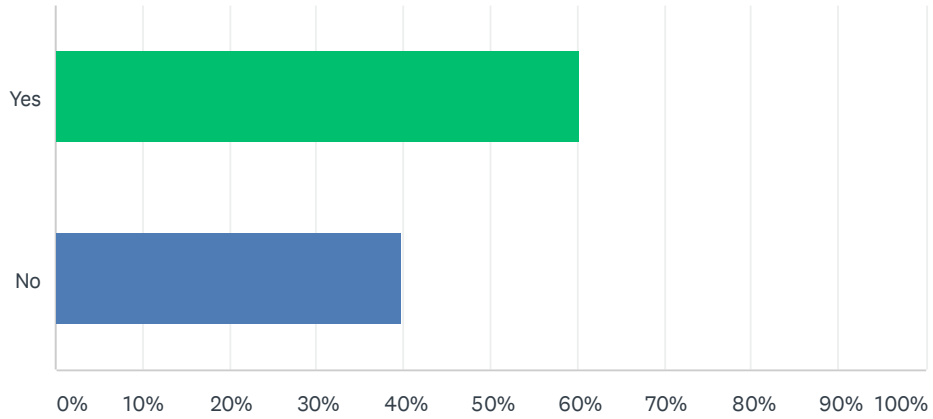

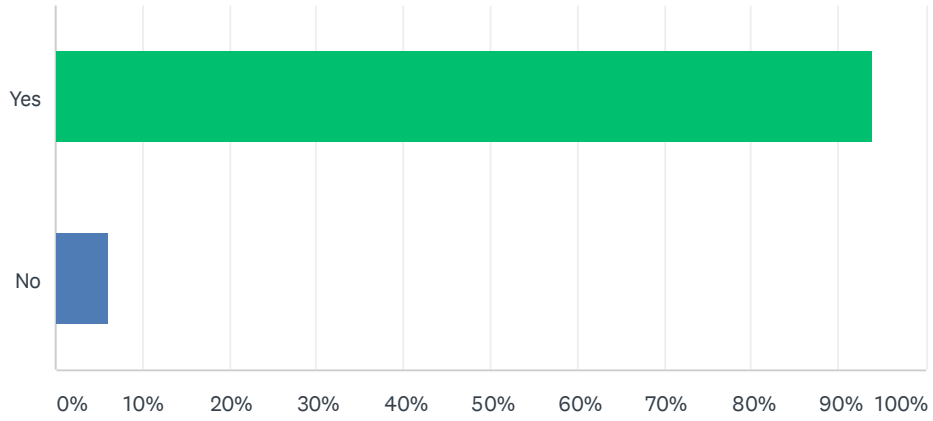

## Q25 Do you currently have adequate connectivity in your home to participate in remote learning, if necessary?

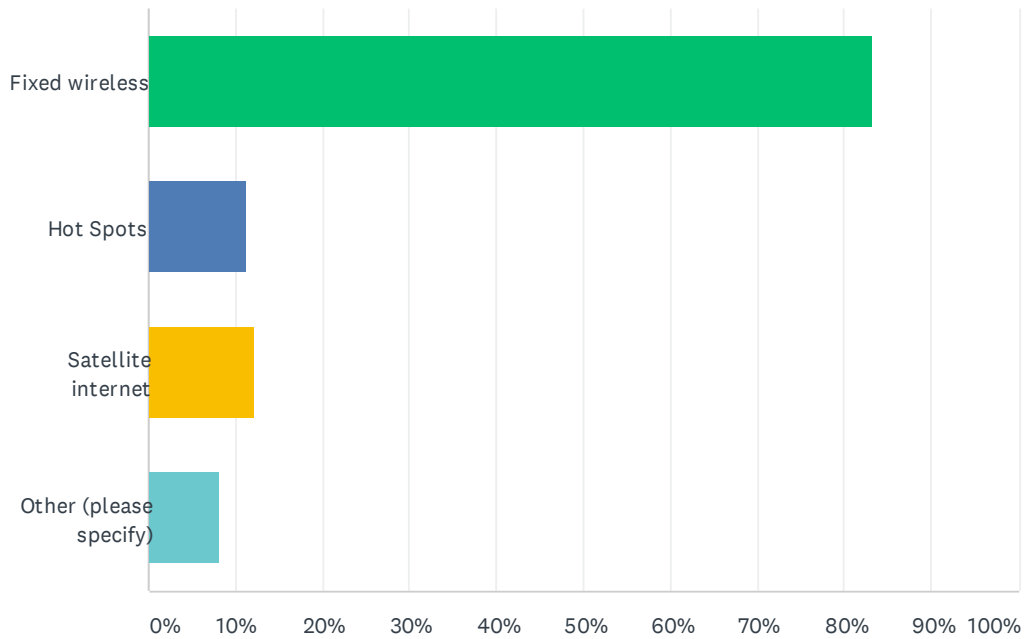
