

Q1 When school reopens for in-person instruction, how likely are you to send your child?





Q2 When school reopens for in-person instruction, would you prefer that your child wears a mask?





Q3 When school reopens for in-person instruction, would you prefer that your child's teachers wear a mask?





Q4 My child is prepared for short-term remote learning should it happen again?





Q5 Do you have regular daily contact with someone who would be considered "high risk" for contracting COVID-19?





Q6 When it comes to helping your child with remote learning, who is most responsible for keeping that child on track with their learning?



















Q14 Do you have a reliable thermometer to check your child's temperature each morning?





Q15 Assuming appropriate safety measures are in place, what is your preference for how your child returns to school in the fall?





Q16 If in-person learning resumes in the fall, how comfortable are you having your child return to the school building?







Q21 How concerned are you about your child's social-emotional well being?






