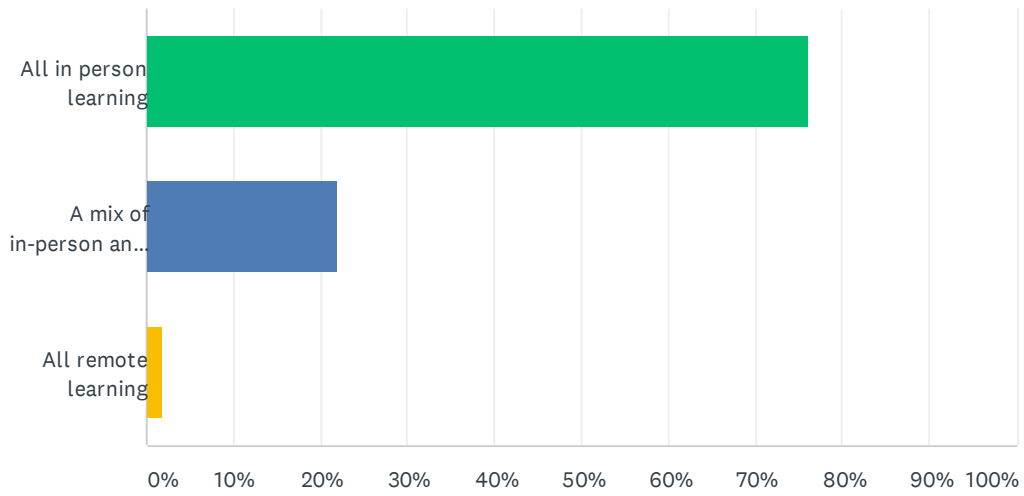


Q1 Assuming appropriate safety measures are in place, what is your preference for returning to school in the fall?

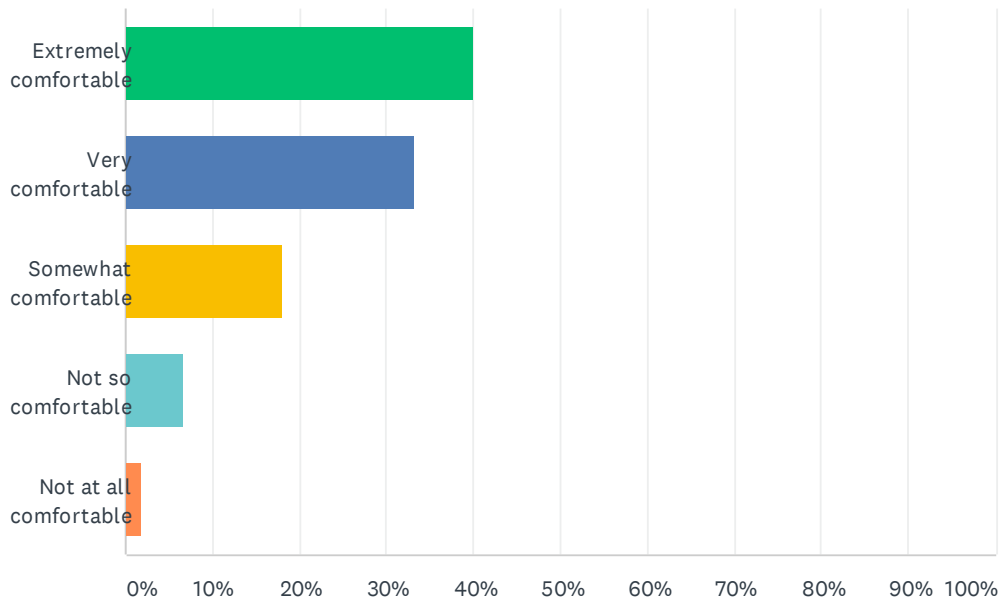

Q2 If in-person learning resumes in the fall, how comfortable are you returning to school?

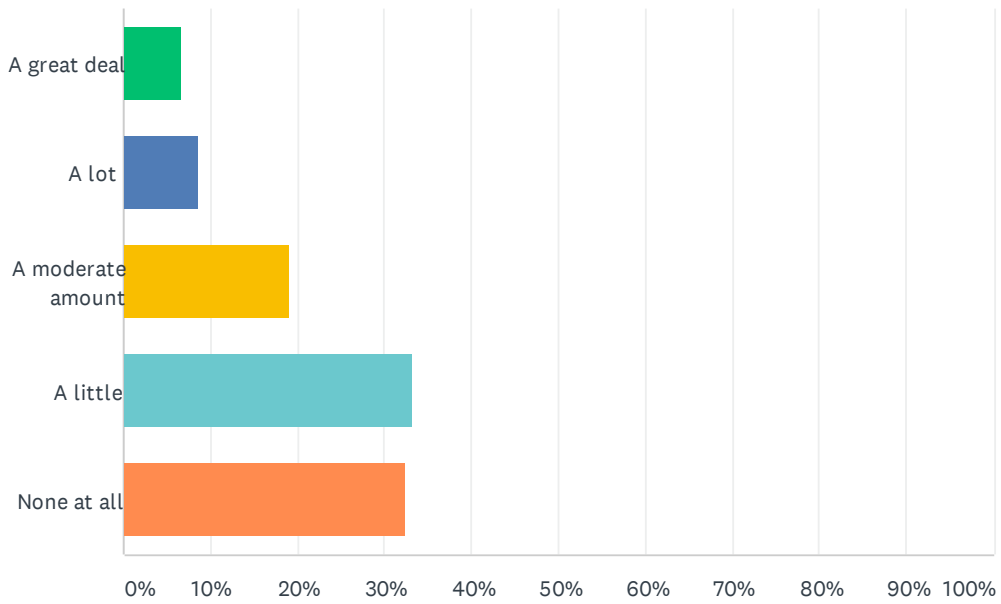

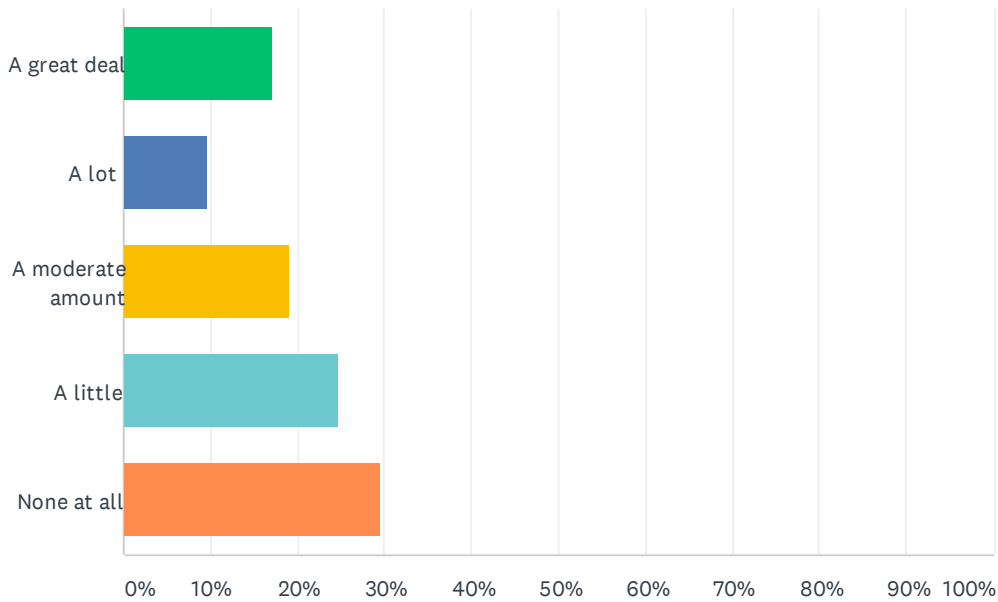

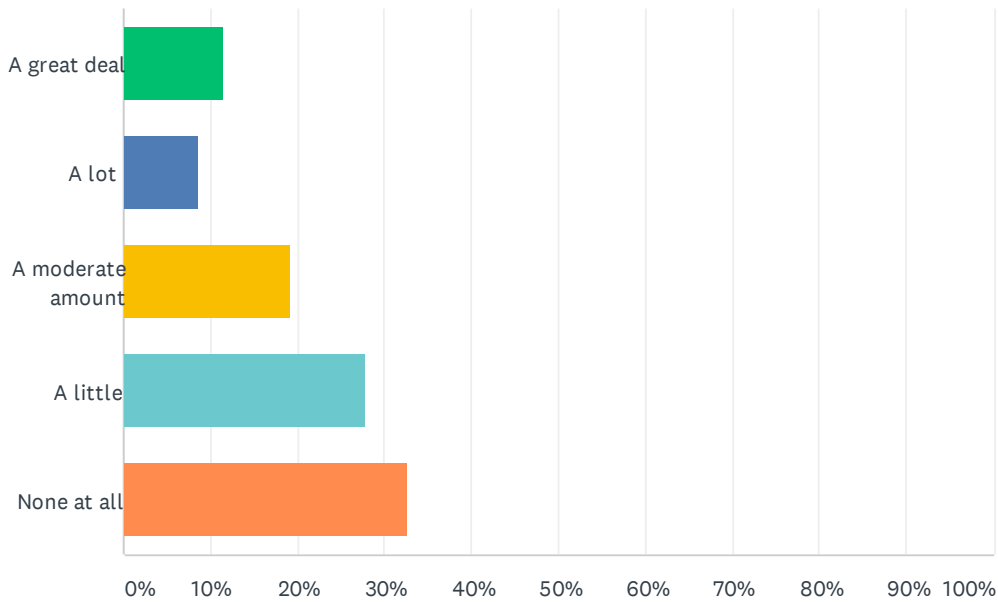

Q5 If in-person learning resumes in the fall, how concerned are you about accessing personal protective equipment for classrooms?

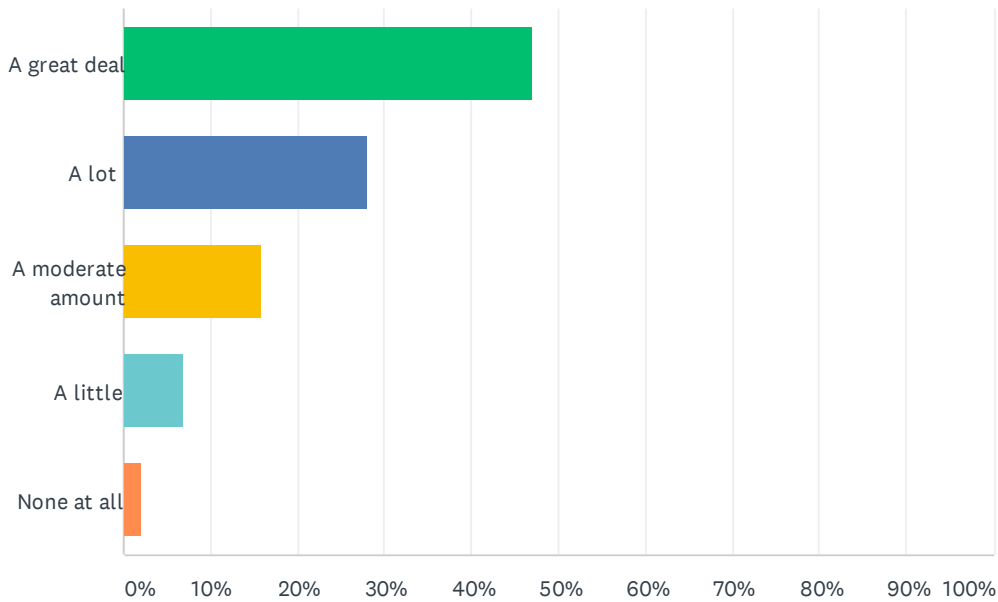

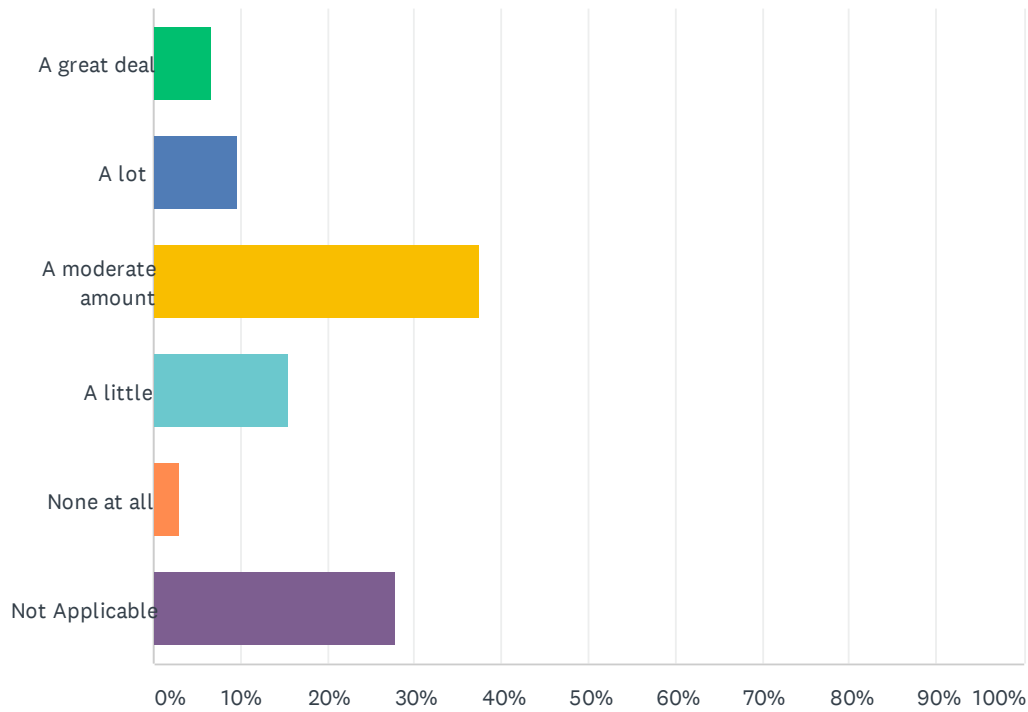

Q8 During distance learning in the spring, typically how engaged were your students?

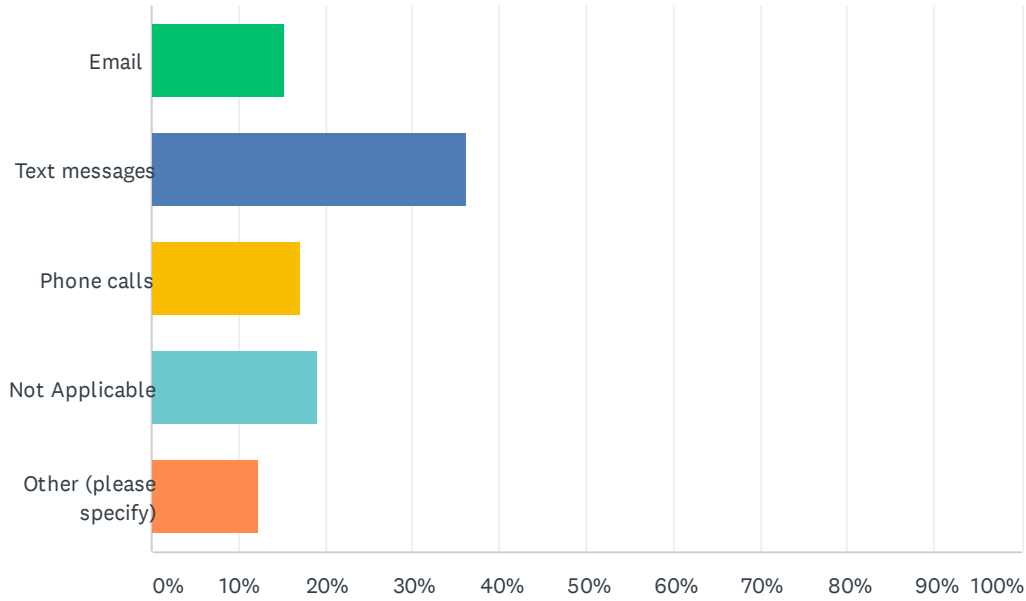

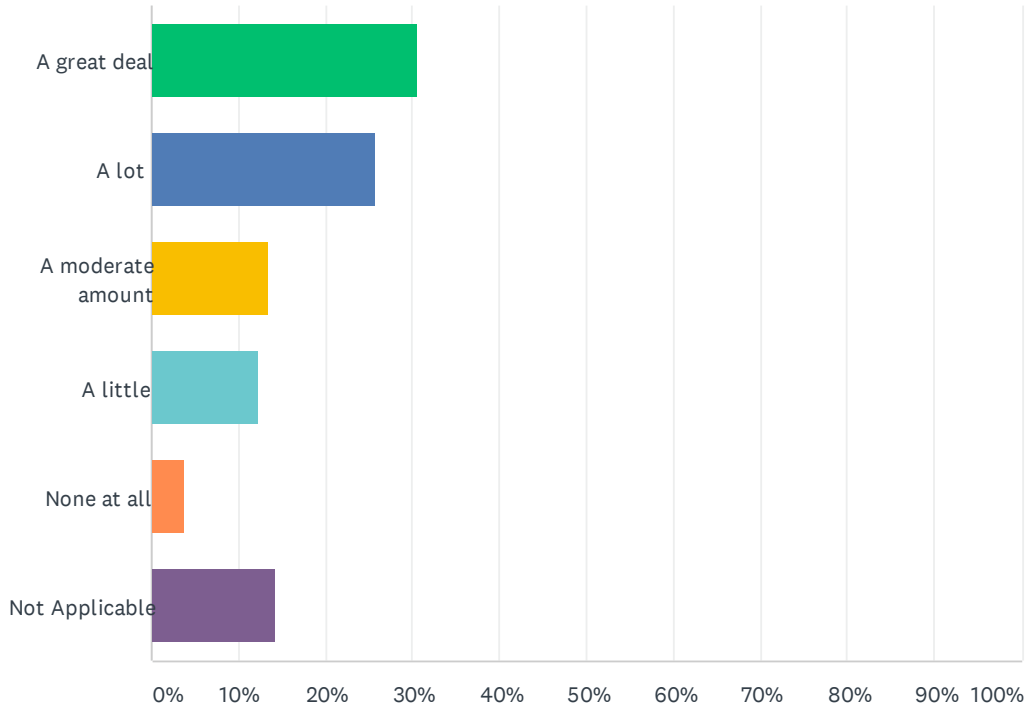

Q12 During distance learning in the spring, how concerned were you about your students' social-emotional well-being?

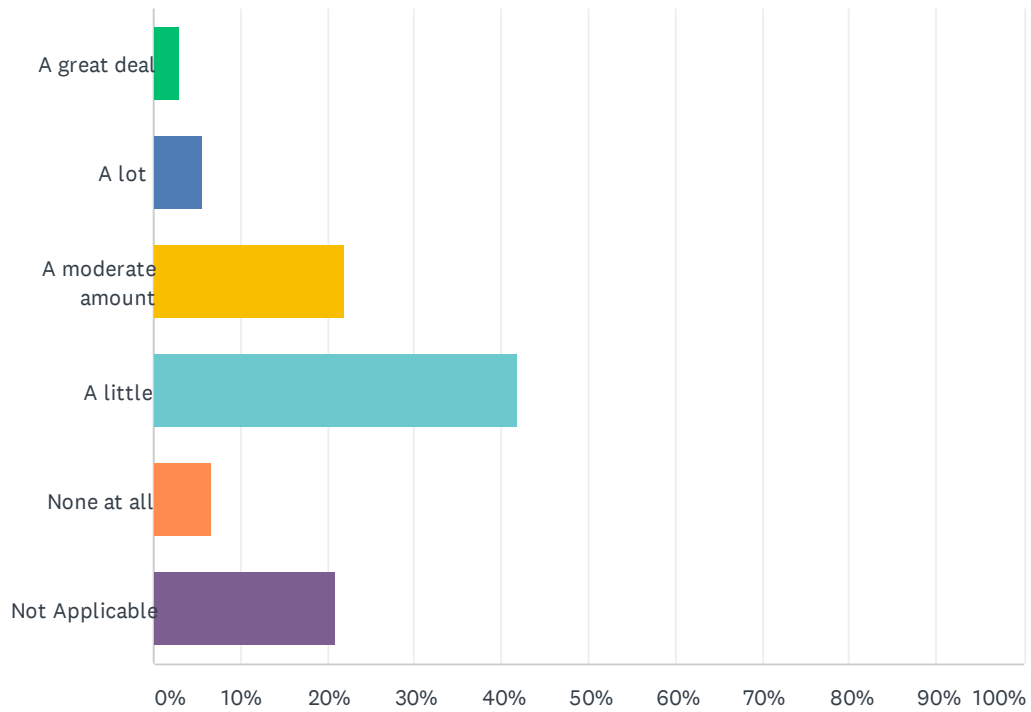

Q13 How confident are you that your students made sufficient academic progress this spring?

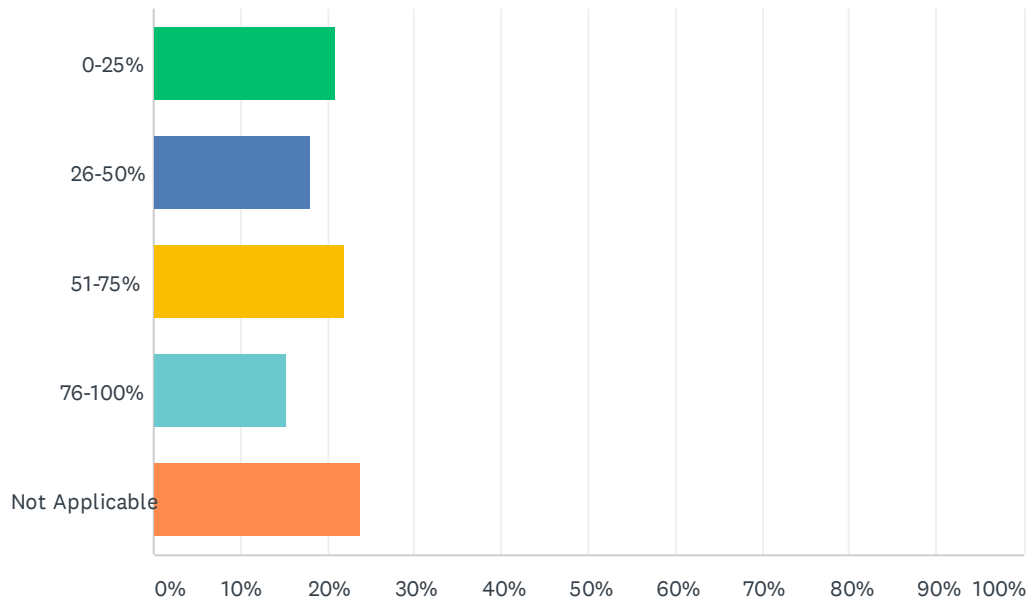

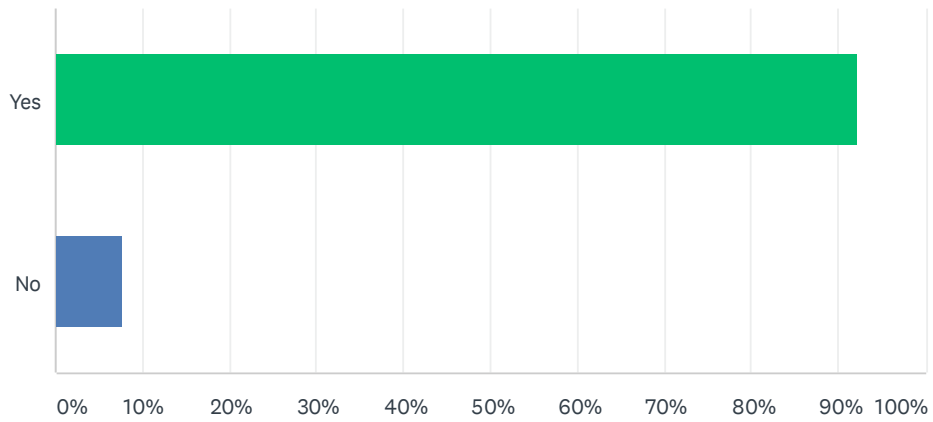

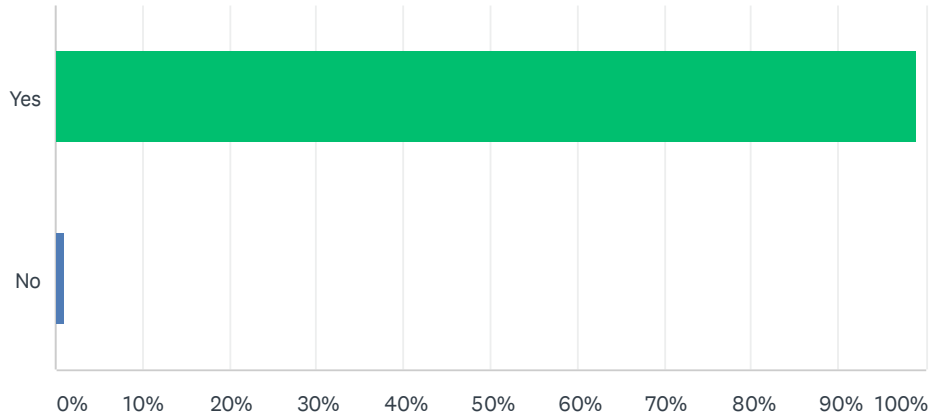

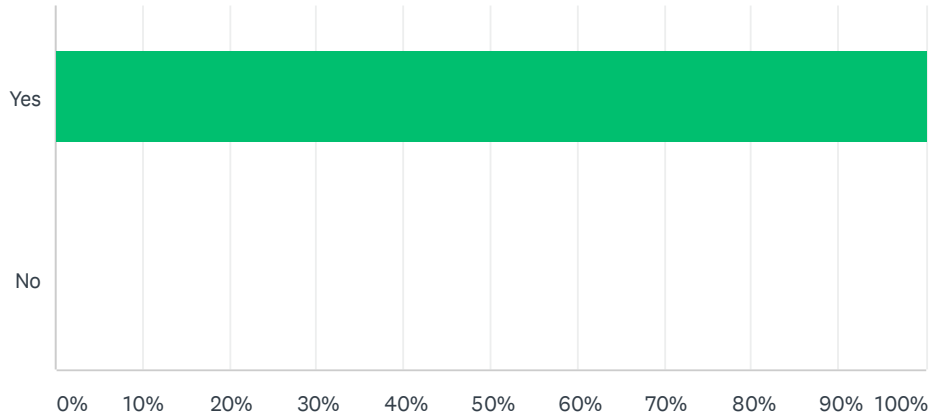

Q18 In order to keep the schools open, would you be willing to abide by all school requirements/regulations including immediately reporting COVID-19 symptoms?

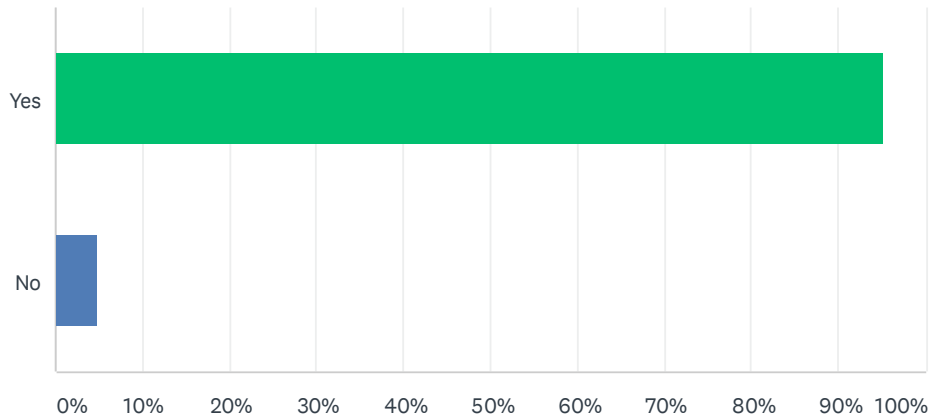

Q19 In order to keep the schools open, would you be willing to abide by all school requirements/regulations including complying with all social distancing guidelines?

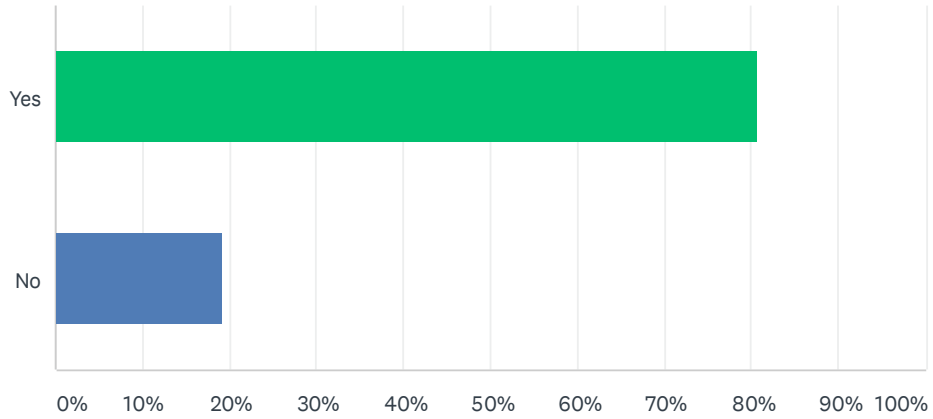

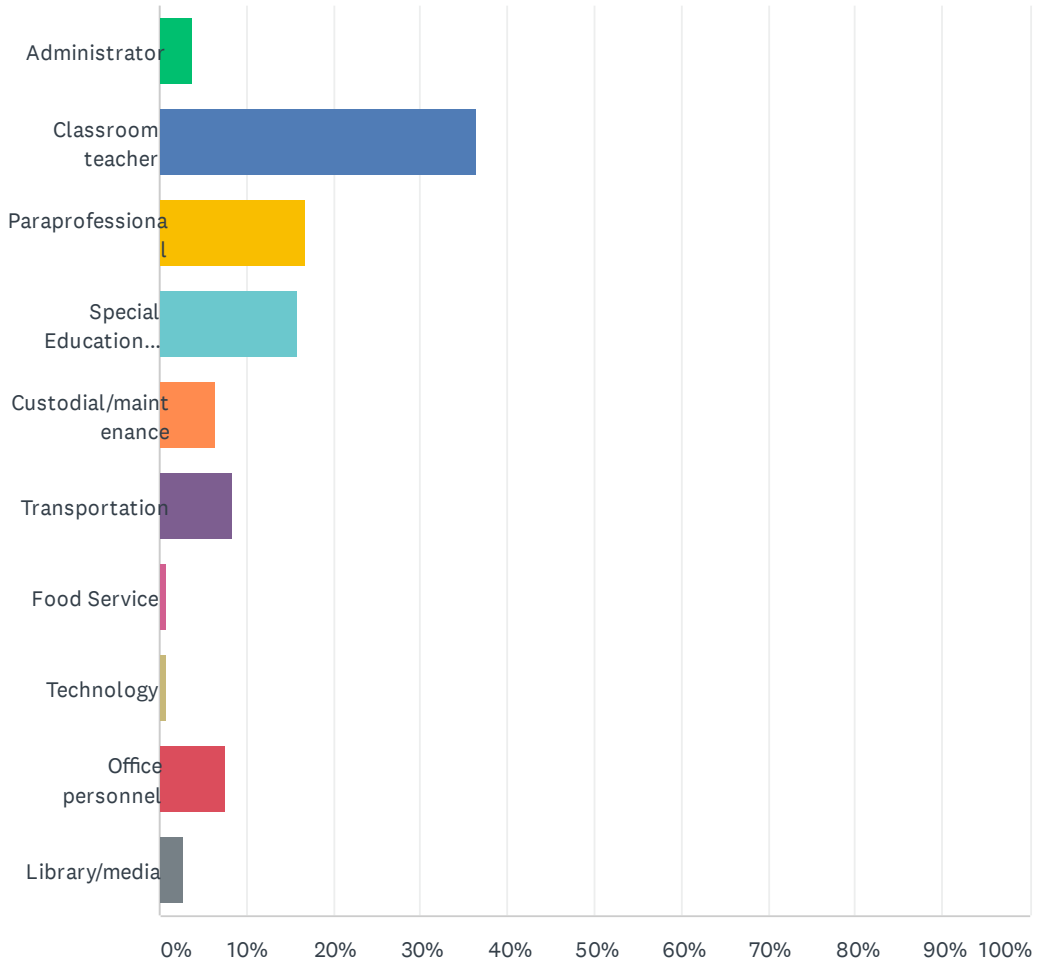
