For Health Visits that are not medical emergencies, please call the nurse before sending a student whenever possible. Also, the nurse may be able to do a classroom visit for non-sick students. Please make sure the student is wearing their mask when they come to the office.

- -Diarrhea
- -Nausea and/or Vomiting
- -Headache
- -Myalgia
- -Fatigue
